Gospel Partner Update: Oriel & Heather O'Gorman (Ireland)

<u>PREACHING OPPORTUNITIES</u>: Oriel had some great opportunities to speak in other churches (one of them in Spain!) and there are many opportunities to do evangelism training in Ireland. It is a blessing to get to equip and inspire God's people and to see how God is BUILDING His church! Oriel recently trained a church planting team in County Wexford. **Please pray that God will do great things as they launch out in a needy area**.

Our weekly Zoom Bible Study is going strong, with 2 new students joining. We finished John's gospel (after 2+ years!) and will start Acts. This HIGHLY interactive study is continually a blessing to all involved, including our family! It is mostly believers, but **pray that any who need to trust Christ will do so.** WICKLOW/RATHNEW: Over the last 2 1/2 years, we've had good openness to the gospel and good response to door-to-door outreach, children's clubs and Evangelistic Bible Studies (2). But we have started to find it difficult to get traction with outreach in this area due to the lack of a local Gospel-teaching church. George and Scarlett, a wonderful Christian couple who live in the area, have been burdened to see a church started in Rathnew for sometime so we are praying seriously about teaming up with them and their church to launch a new church! We take part in a weekly Bible Study in George and Scarlett's home and we hosted a Friday Prayer Meeting for Gospel Advance in Rathnew and had about 20 believers in attendance. **Please pray for wisdom for all of us, and the success of**

the Rathnew Church Plant!

EASTER KIDS CLUB: God blessed us to have 11 kids at our Easter Kids Club, including some brand-new kids who have never come before. It is encouraging to meet new families in the area who need Christ! One girl from the club said it was the highlight of her summer, so the clubs are FUN!



UNEXPECTED OPPORTUNITIES: During our transition from one mission board to another in 2024, we lost some financial support. To pay some bills in the short term, Oriel began driving a school bus for special needs children 3 mornings each week. Interestingly, his route takes him to... you guessed it... Wicklow Town, Rathnew and Ashford. God has not only provided financially; it has been a REVOLUTIONARY experience for Oriel as he relearns how to live and share Christ in the work place.*Please pray for: Imelda, Seamus* (Oriel's Boss,) Rena, Shirley, Pat, Cathal and others to trust Christ! Heather has also been busy caring for a Ukrainian girl almost exactly Rose's age. Nadia's Mum recently started asking questions when she saw a Bible verse on our wall!

Please pray for the O'Gorman family as they are spending this summer in the US visiting churches to raise additional support.
