Gospel Partner Update: Herb & Janet Hunter (Knysna, S. Africa)

Herb's latest update is full of news about their "Building Strong Families" retreat last Saturday. Dr. John Lehman is a family counselor and has authored parenting books, so Herb invited him to preach at the event while he was already in the country to cover for another missionary on furlough. John's wife, Susie, taught one session for the women. Herb had the teens and his co-worker, George, ministered to the primary kids during the preaching. After a busy Friday setting up tents at the campsite, Saturday was cold and windy, but people enjoyed being together for the sessions. In addition to the Hunter's church, there were families there from all three other church plants in Knysna (Lagoonside Baptist, Cornerstone Fellowship & Lakeside Baptist). A couple Herb has been counseling attended the retreat with their 2 teenage sons. They need godly fellowship so pray that they will continue to connect with the church. Sunday church service was also held at the campsite with Lagoonside Baptist. Everyone helped to haul chairs, tents, tables & various balls back to the storage area afterwards, but it was still almost dark when Herb returned home Sunday.



Please pray for Janet's ongoing health issues and hospitalizations. Just this week, the doctor finally diagnosed a fungal infection and prescribed anti-fungal antibiotics for her recurring infections and chronic cough. The urgent request is a permanent meeting place for their church. They were using someone's garage, but a difficult neighbor was complaining & interfering. After reporting them for zone violations, JD, who owns the property, received a cease and desist letter from the Knysna Municipality demanding that the church be gone in 30 days or face fines. Another neighbor called the police to report a noise violation on Sunday. Imagine their surprise when the police came and discovered there was no noise at all because the whole group was at the campsite! In light of everything, their church is moving to the annex room of the Brenton Community Hall. It's not ideal, but workable, and a local realtor is trying to get the property listed so they would have the possibility of purchase.

Today, May 5, their church has a baptism. Outdoor pools are too cold this time of year, so another church gave them use of their heated baptistery. Several of these people were sprinkled as babies or baptized after salvation but not by immersion. This is a big step for the people participating and the church is excited to celebrate their obedience.
