

MISSIONARY UPDATE: MATT & COURTNEY JONES -THAILAND

MINISTRY MADNESS

SEA MK Camp: Our annual Southeast Asia MK camp is a highlight for dozens of missionary families in this part of the world. We have a great team of missionary families who lead games, preach, counsel, have fun, and freely give of their time to be a blessing to the nearly 80 MKs who join us each year. This year, we had kids from Thailand, Cambodia, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Taiwan, & China.

South Africa MK Camp 2025: The value of Missionary Kid camps can't be overstated. In a few months, we will travel with Matt and Kelly Collier of Camps Abroad/ the Wilds to George, South Africa, to kick off the first-ever MK camp there.



Khao Dee Baptist Church: Last year, we started off strong with a good group of expats for our English services and a really, really small group of Thais. Over the past six months, we've seen that paradigm shift quite a bit. Several of our expats have moved away but for almost a month now, we've had around 10 Thai attendees (plus the Jones and Dasantad families)! A number of the Thai attendees are asking about membership. We thank the Lord for the opportunities to preach and teach in this city.

Visa Victories: Ilf you've read many of our updates, you know that visa issues have historically consumed about 4-5 months of our lives each year. We've had lost paperwork (think 250+ pages), questionable requests & officers who wanted our boys to marry their daughters! I'm relieved and thankful to say that this year, after switching our visa type, we eliminated about 80% of the difficulty of doing our visa renewals this year. We have new types of challenges now (more expense & possibly some travel), but they seem to be more more bearable than those of the last 18 years!

HOW CAN YOU PRAY FOR US?

1. Pray for Khao Dee Baptist Church to grow. My burden is to see 12-15 regular Thai attendees by the end of the year. We would also love to see another family who is burdened for the work in Korat as we look at the long-term opportunities to serve in this large city.

- 2. **Pray for the MK camp in South Africa** to be a HUGE blessing to the MKs who will attend. I'm praying for at least 40 MKs for this first year. Courtney and I will be traveling to South Africa and leaving Tyler here in Thailand.
- 3. Keep praying for **our kids and grandgurl** in the States. Pray for God's blessings on them, and pray they grow in grace and wisdom as they serve him in Tennessee, South Carolina, and Florida.
- 4. Courtney and I are both having some knee trouble. Courtney has been struggling with bone spurs on the back of her kneecap along with osteoarthritis that is really causing her some pain and hindering her ability to exercise.

I somehow succeeded in once again tearing the cartilage in my left knee. True story: my knee has been making really loud "KLONK" sounds for a few weeks now, but it didn't really hurt until last week. I actually rolled over in my sleep one night and thought someone had attacked me with a knife. Turns out I tore my meniscus in my sleep. That's taking "old age" to a whole new level. I'll be having surgery in a couple of weeks here in Thailand.

- 5. Pray for Courtney and me as we continue to work through the certification process with the Association of Certified Biblical Counselors. This effort is comparable to earning a master's degree and normally takes 2-3 years to complete. I'm currently in the middle of the final phase, and Courtney is in the middle of the second phase.
- 6. I'm hoping to write and publish another MK devotional by the end of this year. This is a big burden on my heart as I regularly hear encouraging feedback about both the Born to Be Global devotional that I wrote in 2019 for MKs and the MKs in Focus: Thinking Biblically About the MK Experience book for parents and those who care about the well-being of MKs. Pray specifically that I can find someone to help with the formatting so that I can make this book available to sell online as a fill-in-the-blank Bible study.
- 7. We have several immediate family members who are battling with various forms and stages of cancer. Pray for grace and healing and that they would walk in faith and peace through the journey.
